Do this in Memory....

This year in our parish, for the first time, we will be running the 'Do this in Memory' programme for the children making their First Communion during the month of May next year. This programme is a parish based programme aimed at helping children prepare to receive this important sacrament. It doesn't replace but compliments the preparation that takes place in school and also helps parents and guardians by providing material they can use at home to pray with and talk to their children about the sacrament.

The programme takes place on one Sunday each month for the eight months leading up to the celebration of First Communion, with an additional one taking place on Corpus Christi when everyone has received their First Communion. It takes place during the normal Sunday Mass and in this way it invites and involves the wider parish community to help the children prepare for their sacraments through their prayer and support. On each of the Sunday's of the programme the parents/guardians and families of those preparing for First Communion are invited to prepare for and participate in this Mass and each month a group of parents and guardians will meet to plan and coordinate the next Sunday of the programme.

The first Sunday of this programme will be take place next weekend (4th October) at both the 9: 30 am and 11: 30 am Mass. This will be their Enrolment Sunday, when both the children with their parents / guardians, will make promises to commit themselves to the programme and when the wider parish community will agree to help them with us all renewing our baptismal promises.

We hope this programme will enhance the preparation the children receive during the year ahead, but also that it will help families and the wider parish community grow in their knowledge and understanding of their faith and what the Eucharist means to us all.
