- Offering our gifts to be shared
- Coming to the table to receive Communion or a blessing.

In other words, we are all part of the action! In Church language this is called 'full, active and conscious participation'.

Raphoe Diocesan Society

The month of November is a good time to remind you of the Raphoe Diocesan Society. You are encouraged to have your deceased relatives enrolled in the Society and you yourselves are encouraged to become Living Members. Any person wishing to become a member of the Raphoe Diocesan Society may apply to any of the Diocesan Clergy. An Annual Mass will be offered for the deceased members of the Raphoe Diocesan Society and the prayers of the people of the diocese will be requested for the same intention on the weekend following the publication of the quarterly list of members who died during the previous quarter. Four Masses (of perpetual foundation) shall be offered in each parish each year—two Masses for the living members and two for the deceased members and benefactors of this society. The fee for enrolling members is €15 for each member.

The Annual Mass for the Deceased Members of the Society will be celebrated in Mary Star of the Sea Church, Annagry on Tuesday, 10th November at 7pm.
