The Candle Shrines

People light candles each day for a special person, a special intention, for someone who is ill, in hospital, a person who is dying. We all light candles for special people and intentions and we pray for them.

In this Church we ask that you make a little donation of 25¢ for each candle you light.

We have noticed many people lighting candles each day and they do not make a donation. For some, we know they can not afford the 25¢ ...but most can afford this small donation. For example, a few mornings ago, a lady lit 40 candles and did not leave any donation.

This Parish has to buy these candles. If this practise continues there will simply be no Candle Shrines. Please do not make this happen.
