LEARNING ABOUT THE MASS



The Altar

Another word for Altar is table. The Altar table is in the centre of the part of God's House that we call the sanctuary. Sanctuary means 'holy' and this indeed is a holy place. The servers prepare the Altar. They put the following on the Altar:

The Corporal: a square shaped white cloth on which the paten and chalice are placed.

The Roman Missal: the book from which the priest reads the prayers.

The Purificators: small white towels which are used to clean the chalice and paten later in the Mass.
