Passion Sunday/ Palm Sunday

Holy Week begins on Palm Sunday. At Mass we will hear the events of the week unfold as the Passion of Christ according to Luke is read. But at the opening of Mass, we remember Christ's entrance into Jerusalem to accomplish the paschal mystery - we stand with Jesus at the beginning of the final journey to Jerusalem, a journey from "Hosanna!" to "Crucify".

We are facing the mystery of suffering and death in the life of Christ. In our own lives, we cannot escape this confrontation. We each travel our own unique journey, our personal pathway to Calvary. We do not know what the journey may mean for us, and where it might end.
